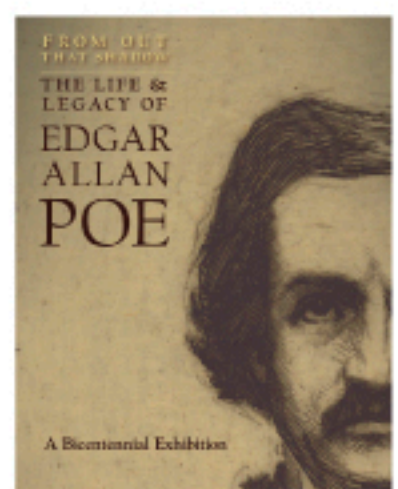
From Out That Shadow: The Life and Legacy of Edgar Allan Poe
